



Kings Pride Buffalo

Kings Pride Soft Leaf Buffalo Turf is a grass that stays greener for longer in summer and winter, softer than ever and hard-wearing it looks better and is sure to outperform or match any other buffalo turf. Kings Pride Soft Leaf Buffalo was first discovered growing wild in various regions around the country, what more proof is needed of its natural ability to thrive the testing climate of Australia. Ideal for domestic and commercial lawns

Turf Characteristics

- Vibrant colour all year round
- Excellent shade tolerance
- Recovers quickly from wear and tear

Sapphire Buffalo

Sapphire Soft Leaf Buffalo is ideal for residential and commercial lawns, it performs as good as any other buffalo turf, with the added benefit of fine texture. It grows quickly across the ground, providing quick recovery from wear and tear. Unlike other fine-leaved buffalo grasses, it does not have thatch problems, shallow roots or poor wear characteristics.

Turf Characteristics

- Excellent winter colour (provided it is fertilised in April)
- Thrives in hot humid and desert areas
- Excellent drought tolerance & good salt tolerance
- Moderate to good shade tolerance
- Excellent wear resistance with fast recovery

Grand Prix Couch

Grand Prix is the first Australian couch grass released on the market that is the result of a classic breeding program. Grand Prix is dark green in colour, is fine to medium in texture and its leaf is described as short. Grand Prix is best suited to sports fields, parks, golf courses and school ovals.

Turf Characteristics

- Rapid growth rate
- Low seed head numbers
- High water tolerance
- Low water requirements
- Excellent colour
- An ideal sports field surface

Conquest Couch

Conquest Couch is a prestige lawn that will compliment your home or a high profile sporting surface and is very user friendly, with a fine to medium texture that is soft on children and pets. It is environmentally friendly, requiring less watering because of its deeper root system than other green couches.

Conquest Couch thrives in hot high temperatures and has a high drought tolerance. Conquest is the ideal couch for high profile golf courses, sports fields and any area that requires a high performance hard wearing surface.

Turf Characteristics

- Bright green in colour with a fine medium textured blade
- Winter active (may go dormant in VIC for 10 wks)
- Quick to establish root system, reaches 100mm in 21 days
- Excellent wear tolerance, quick to recover from damage
- Low water and fertiliser requirements
- Will not tolerate heavily shaded areas
- Requires 5 - 6 hours of sunlight per day to thrive

Kikuyu

Kikuyu is a good, hardy, low maintenance lawn, it grows vigorously in the summer months therefore this variety of turf recovers well from wear and tear. Most suitable for high traffic areas. Kikuyu has best results in full sun and does not grow well in the shade.

Kikuyu is an easy care, hard wearing turfgrass with a medium texture and yellow, green colour. When well watered, fed and mown regularly it is great for large areas. Kikuyu can become invasive, and therefore is not suitable for small areas. It keeps its colour in the winter months but needs to be maintained in the summer months as it is a fast grower. Kikuyu turf thrives in sunny conditions and has a good resistance to disease and weeds.

Turf Characteristics

- Fast growing, hardy and likes good drainage
- Will grow in most soil types
- Excellent turf for playing fields, schools, footpaths, pre-schools and backyards
- Very strong grass, soft to sit on
- Very economical for replacement if turf wears out
- Good for erosion control

Santa Ana Couch

Santa Ana Couch is the finest of our couch varieties and makes a great disease resistant lawn. Suited to sunny locations or areas with 10%-20% shade throughout the day and best used in high traffic areas such as sporting grounds. Santa Ana is a lighter shade of green compared to the other varieties.

Santa Ana couch grass is a popular turf variety used for sports fields, home lawns, public spaces, golf courses and general utility turf throughout Australia and many parts world. It will withstand extended periods of drought and medium to heavy traffic.

Turf Characteristics

- Hardwearing and quick to self repair
- Super fine rolling texture
- Best lawn for low mowing
- Deep root system
- Superior drought tolerance
- Grows best in full sun situations
- Tolerates most herbicides

Greenlees Park Couch

Greenlees Park Couch is a fine-leaved dwarf variety of lawn which grows well in dry, sunny to lightly shaded areas. Greenlees Park Couch can be mowed with any mower but best results are achieved when a cylinder mower is used. This turf has a dark green colour and retains its colour well during winter, but will be affected by the frost.

Greenlees Park Couch is great for home or commercial lawn giving it a deep contrasting colour. It is excellent for low maintenance areas such as parks, roadside verges, soil stabilisation and urban fill areas. It is resistant to hard wear and tear and is recommended for Golf Courses and Sports Grounds. It tolerates low mowing and is therefore also suitable for cricket grounds, tennis courts and bowling greens.

Turf Characteristics

- Low maintenance
- Excellent heat tolerance
- Good density
- Grows in full sun (needs a minimum of 5 hours sun)
- Grows horizontally and forms a very firm surface
- Low shade tolerance
- Good winter colour retention
- High tolerance to most herbicide

Winter Green Couch

Winter Green Couch is a fine-leaved lawn similar to Greenlees Park, with the main difference being Winter Green handles frost a little better. This turf is most suited to sunny areas and can also handle a position with 10%-20% shade. It can tolerate wear and tear well and is also quite disease resistant. Winter Green Couch is a very deep green colour. If fertilised, Wintergreen Couch retains its colour very well in winter.

Wintergreen Couch is ideal for areas that receive a great amount of wear and tear from traffic, it is also suitable for council footpaths, walkways and easements. Wintergreen couch has been the turf variety preferred for sporting surfaces for over 20 years.

Turf Characteristics

- Durable and robust – withstands heavy wear
- Excellent cold and frost tolerance
- Tolerates a wide range of soils
- Readily adapts to different environments
- Thrives in sunny areas (requires 7 hours of sun)
- Budget turf variety

Sir Walter Buffalo Turf

Sir Walter is a versatile, turf forming, warm season C4 soft leaf buffalo turf grass that is a native to the East Coast of Australia. Being a native species it is naturalised to coastal seashore environments but is highly adaptive to a large range of climatic and soil conditions.

Turf Characteristics

- Australia's Number 1 Buffalo Lawn
- Drought tolerant and tough
- Requires little mowing and fertilising
- Disease and fungus resistant
- Great in full sun and shade
- Australian Born and Bred
- Weed resistant
- Self repairing

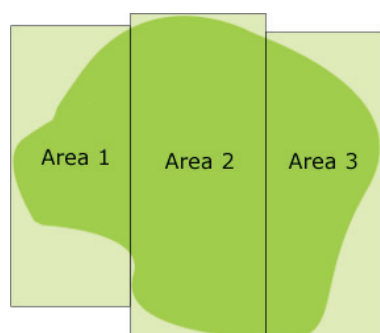
How to Prepare Your Site

1. All existing lawns and weeds need to be sprayed with Roundup 14 days before laying your new lawn.
2. Excavation is needed if the existing ground is compacted and the levels are too high against paths and driveways. The level should be 150mm to 200mm below any path.
3. Soil quality. Your local nursery will be able to give you advice. If it is of poor quality (clay based or too sandy) this can be rectified by purchasing a good quality top soil from your local nursery. Quantity of soil required for every 100 sq metres is between 5 and 10 tonnes, which will give you a depth of 25mm to 50mm.
4. Spread the top soil out evenly using a rake or a piece of timber. Making the surface, to be turfed, as flat as possible will give a better result.
5. If the top soil doesn't have any fertilizers mixed in then add, at the recommended rate, fertilizer/lawn food to the area to get the best possible results.
6. If your soil is of good quality, this should be sprayed with Roundup and left for the 14 days, as above. The area needs to be worked over to a depth of 100 – 200mm (hire a cultivator or a rotary hoe for larger areas).
7. Water within 30 minutes of laying. Turf requires immediate soil contact and moisture to thrive.

How to Measuring Your Site

Measure the length and width in metres and multiply the two measurements.

If you have an irregular shape, draw a plan and draw rectangles over the area and add up the total in square metres. **Example: Area 1 + Area 2 + Area 3**



How to Lay Your Turf

1. Prepare the area prior to ordering your turf.
2. Dampen the soil where the turf is to be installed.
3. The turf needs to be installed and watered immediately after being delivered.
4. Start with a straight line, along the longest edge, perhaps a driveway or boundary line.
5. Unroll the turf across the area in a staggered pattern (similar to bricklaying). If the ground is sloped, align the pattern across the slope. This minimizes the possibility of trenches forming between the rolls.
6. Make sure the turf rolls are butted tightly together. Avoid leaving gaps or overlapping. Gaps will allow air to get in between the rolls and dry the edges out.
7. Shape the turf rolls around objects (garden beds, trees, drains etc.) by cutting it to fit with a sharp spade or knife.
8. On a large lawn it is best to do it in smaller sections so that you can water as you go.
9. Thoroughly water your new lawn after installing and keep it moist in the first week or two.
10. Fertilise your lawn after the turf has taken root in the soil. Usually around 5 weeks after installation.

For best results the turf should be layed on the day it is delivered. Check with our staff about different watering requirements during various seasons.
